


The Brandel-Murphy Youth Foundation Invites MD-20 Lions, Friends & Family to Cruise from Metro NYC to the Bahamas!

Prime space is being held for friends and supporters of the Brandel-Murphy Youth Foundation sailing, for seven nights from Cape Liberty (just 11 miles from NYC) October 13-20, 2024, for a fun-filled adventure including Royal Caribbean's renowned "Perfect Day at Coco Cay" private beach resort, with additional visits to Port Canaveral and Nassau in the Bahamas. Please treat yourself to this grand adventure, while benefiting our mission to support Lions projects to improve the lives of children in New York State and Bermuda.

The Royal Caribbean *Symphony* of the Seas, a ship that eclipses the U.S. Navy's Nimitz-class supercarriers, features a tropical park (with over 20,000 living plants and trees), the "Boardwalk" with a classic Carousel and hot dogs to rival Coney Island, an ice skating rink with shows reminiscent of the famed *Ice Capades*, a zipline for the daring, and an outdoor amphitheater with water shows featuring world class divers, all onboard. *Royal Caribbean has created a resort destination that floats*.

Want to see a show? Head to Deck 4. Ready for a dip in the pool or a round of miniature golf, or a surfing lesson? Deck 15 is the designated sports zone. Hungry? Most restaurants -- <u>there are 24!</u> -- are on decks 5, 6, and 8.

Though this ship can accommodate more than 6,000 guests, there are plenty of private, cozy spaces onboard. The Symphony's Central Park is longer than a football field and completely open to the sky. It is a wonderful, serene space, with winding paths and benches and a half-dozen restaurants for outdoor dining.

The Boardwalk, modeled after old time Coney Island, with its merry-go-round and ice-cream parlor, also is home to *Symphony*'s AquaTheater, a 700-seat amphitheater, overlooking an 18-foot-deep swimming pool, which hosts Olympic caliber diving shows. Nine stories above the boardwalk stretches an 82-foot long zipline for adventurous passengers to enjoy. Other onboard activities include surfing on two Flowrider machines, rock climbing, miniature golf, ice skating, dancing, basketball, and yes, of course, pickleball, ping pong, and shuffleboard!

The Solarium, located forward on the 16th deck, is a gorgeous, adults only haven of relaxation! They have a freshwater pool and two tranquil whirlpools, palm trees, a cocktail lounge, and the spa café.

The entertainment options on board are vast. The *Symphony* offers great musical shows in its main theater (some of which you may have seen on Broadway) along with nightclub acts and traditional cruise entertainment you are sure to enjoy. Plan to visit the Comedy club and music venues galore. The Casino and lounges will be open until the wee hours of the morning.

The food is great, diverse, and plentiful. Restaurants range from New York Elegant to Johnny Rockets for burgers, french fries, and milk shakes. Perhaps you might prefer the Italian Bistro or sushi bar? The options seem endless. The gym is state of the art and the spa is luxurious.
